# Communications

This term we will be working with Bristol City Council for sustainable travel.

Year 5 are currently working with the travel team, looking at our local areas and the impact cars are having.

Over the next few weeks we will be having:

- 24/6/24 Dr Bike: We have 15 spaces for bikes to see a mobile mechanic for a service.
- The service is then free to those who attend, including free brake blocks and cables where needed. Each participant is treated to a safety check, and a gear and brake tune up. They are then presented with a form giving a diagnosis of the health of their bike. If a bike needs more work than is possible outside of a workshop environment, we recommend our in-house <u>servicing and repairs</u>. A booking link will be sent closer to the time.
- 27/6/24 Year 1 Scooter Skills: Children will need to bring in their scooters on this day to take part in skills workshops on how to keep safe on their scooter and basic manoeuvring skills. If you do not have a scooter, we have a number that can be borrowed from school.
- 27/6/24 Year 6 Planning Safe Journeys. Children will be working with the travel team on how to ensure their journeys are safe and how to plan safe route.
- 28/6/24– Year 3 and 4 workshop on the benefits of active travel.
- We are working to get Bikeability skills organised for year 2 but this is most likely going to take place after the summer holidays when they are in year 3.
