In EYFS this week we have been using colourful semantics to help us to write sentences based on our class text.



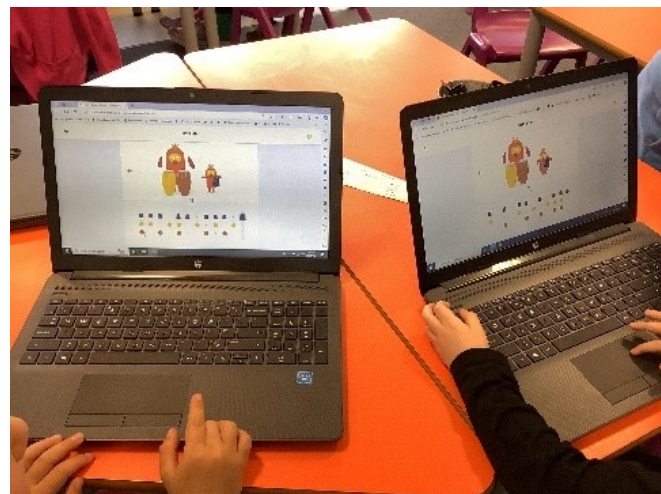
Year 1



Year one have been practicing their mindfulness and breathing techniques to help them when they to calm in class before their learning.

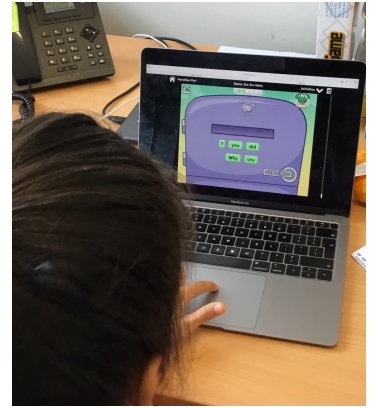
Year 2
