




Dear Parents/Carers,



#### **Learning this term**

#### Travelling Panda/Hippo

Starting on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November each class will be sending home the class Panda or Hippo. They will be sent home in a bag with a book for you write and/or add photos too! This is an opportunity for your child to tell us all about what they have been up to over the weekend. We would love to see them returned before the following Wednesday. We understand that you may not be able to print the photos so please add them to tapestry so that we can add them into the book. We choose to do this as a fun way to develop confidence when speaking and listening to others. It also helps children to practise their writing, reading, phonics and drawing skills.

# Things to bring in each day in Reception:

Please ensure that your child brings the following to school every day:

- School book bag, containing reading book, reading record and phonics sounds to practice with your child
- A named water bottle (water only, not squash or fizzy drinks)
- Named waterproof coat.
- Named wellies
- It would also be useful if you could provide a spare set of (including underwear) in case of any accidents, in a plastic bag, which can be stored safely in the classroom.

\*If your child requires any <u>regular medication</u>, or has an inhaler or epi-pen, this needs to be passed to the school office, who will ask you to complete a medical form and to provide us with more detail about this, including a care plan where necessary.

#### **Reading Books**

It has been fantastic to see that the children have started reading at home with their adults or siblings. Please remember to make a note in their reading record every time this happens. At school, the adults in the classroom are beginning to read more and more with the children alongside consistent phonic check ins. These will be appearing more in their reading records from us this term. We are so proud of their progress! I am sure it must feel exciting to hear them begin to read!
