As we start a new school year, we will remind ourselves about ethics and environment. We will look at what makes a family linking with our Science topic of living things. We will also be looking at how to look after our world.

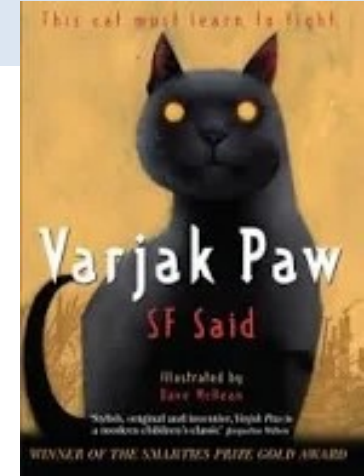
## Art and D.T.
