Fun Phonics Activities at Home

-  Silly Sound Songs – Sing words with specific phonemes (e.g., "sh, sh, ship on the sea").
-  Word Building with Magnetic Letters – Make words using fridge magnets.
-  Roll & Read Game – Write words in a grid, roll a dice, and read the word in that row.
